Regulations: Any student missing three (3) meetings of a course, **for any reason**, will be automatically withdrawn and no fees will be refunded. Three tardies will count as one absence. A tardy of twenty minutes or more will be counted as one (1) absence. Smoking is prohibited on school grounds. Students who violate this rule will be automatically expelled, without refund.

Registration: The PHS Summer Program course registration will be held in Pomperaug High School Main Office, Wednesday, June 18... Thursday, June 19... Friday, June 20. 8:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. You may still sign up for a course on Monday, June 23 and Tuesday, June 24th. But all classes missed will count as absences. A minimum class size of ten (10) is required for a course to run. Price is \$200 per class. ***A separate book deposit of \$50.00 per course*** will be required for non-region 15 students at the time of registration. This can be a check and will be returned or voided after book is returned. If you are signing up for 2 classes, 2 separate checks will be necessary in case one class does not run.

Credits: Science classes will receive 1.25 credits for the course.

All other academic classes will receive 1.0 credits for the course.
