## Available Vaccines

**Quadrivalent flu vaccine \$30** • For persons 6 months and older • the “regular” flu shot

**FluMist Vaccine \$30\*\*** • For persons 2- 49 years • the nasal spray vaccine

**Flublok vaccine\* \$65** • For persons 18 years and older • For adults with egg allergy

\*available only at the weekly Pomperaug Health District office clinics

**High-Dose vaccine \$65** • For persons 65 years and older

Studies have shown that the high-dose flu vaccine is safe and more effective for seniors than the regular flu shot
