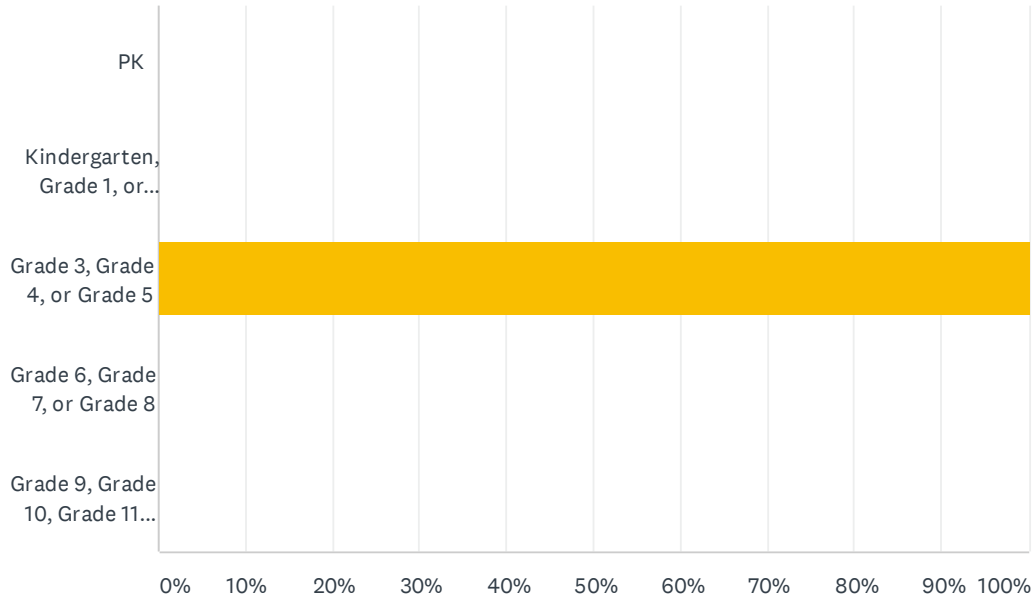

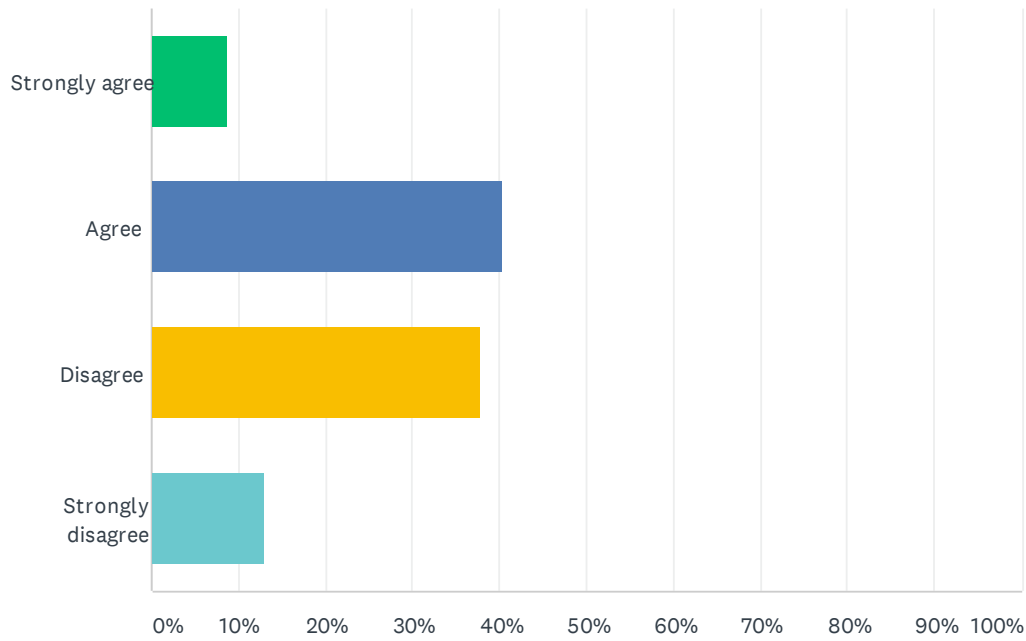

## Q2 As a parent, I found the overall experience of the remote learning environment in Region 15 to be better than expected.

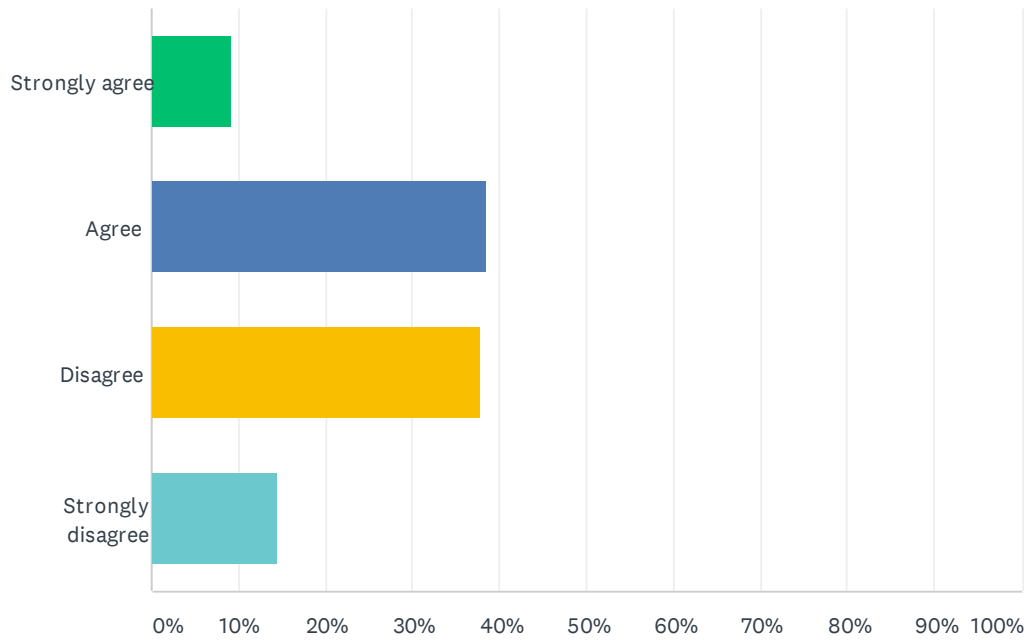

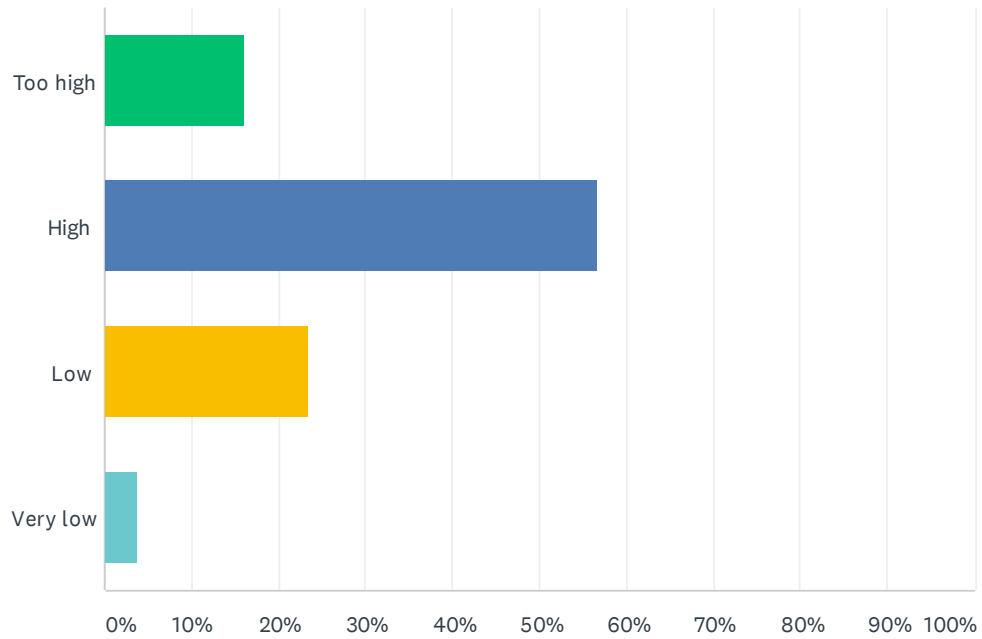

## Q4 The stress level in your home related to remote learning was

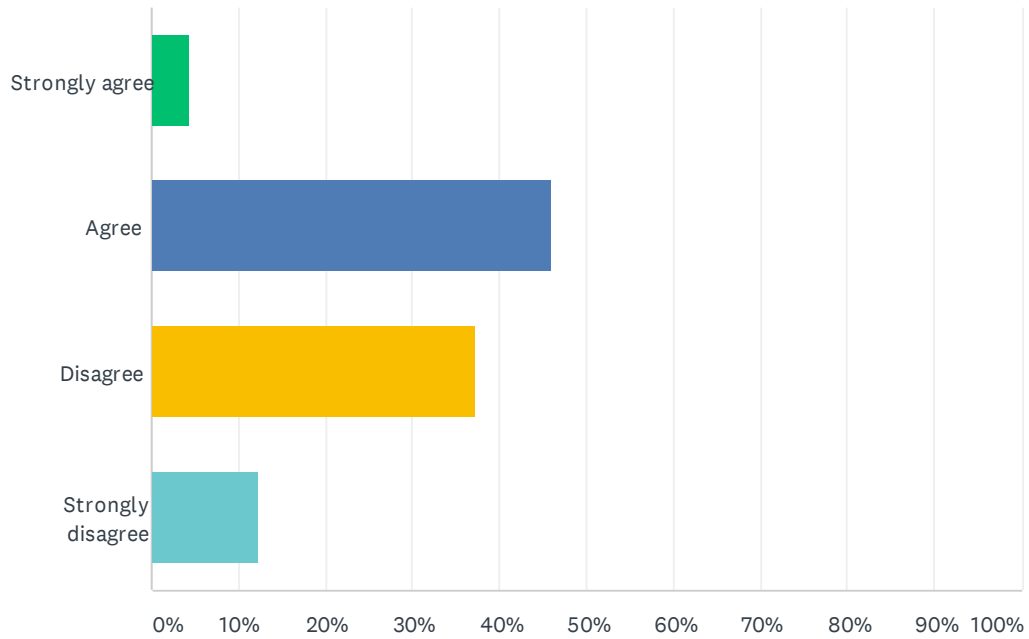

## Q5 I believe the academic "screen time" for my student was just right

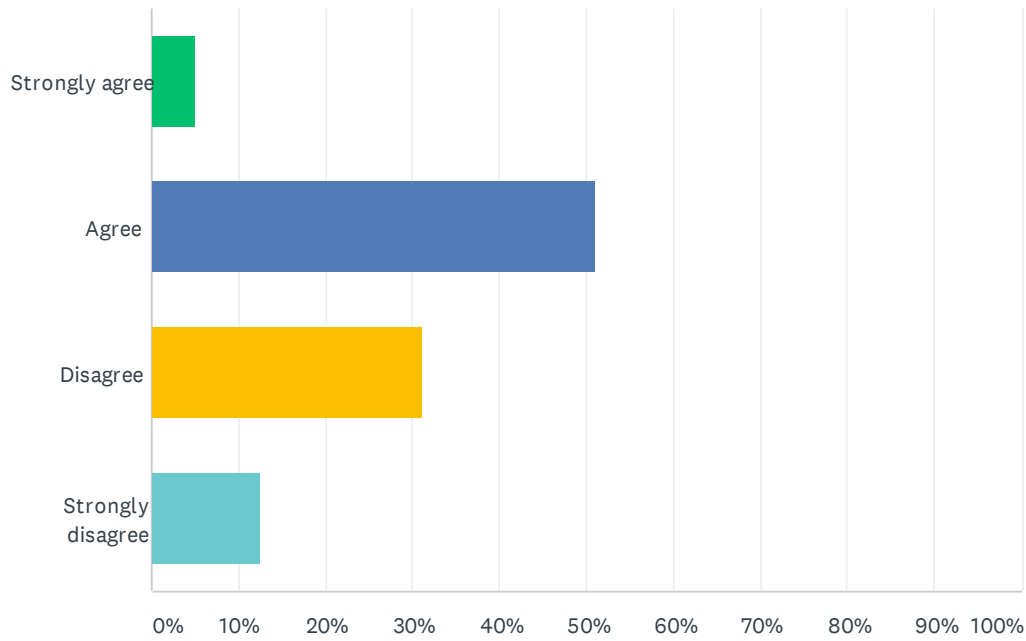

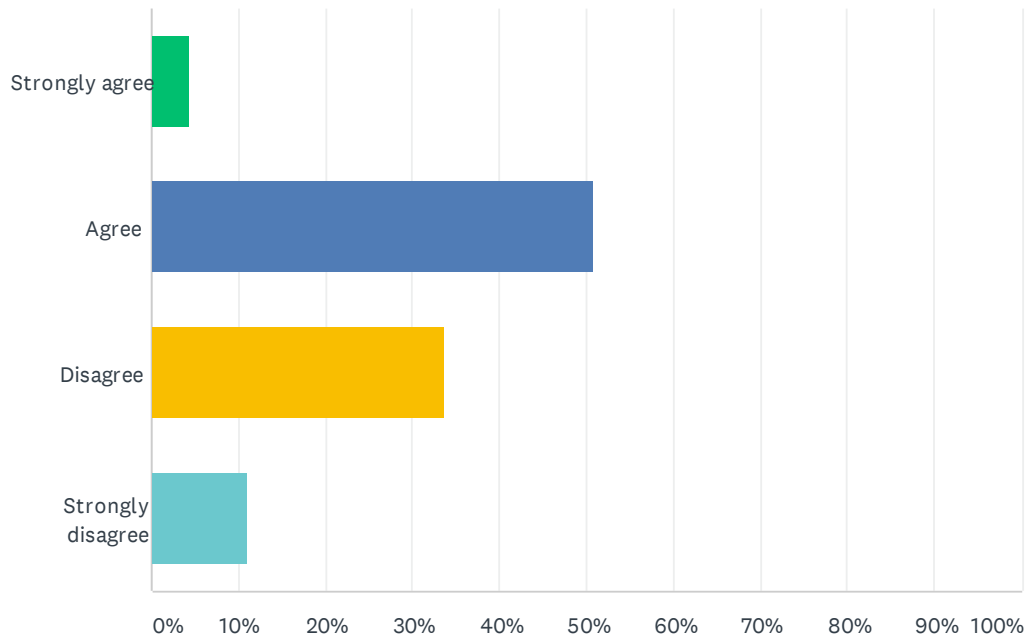

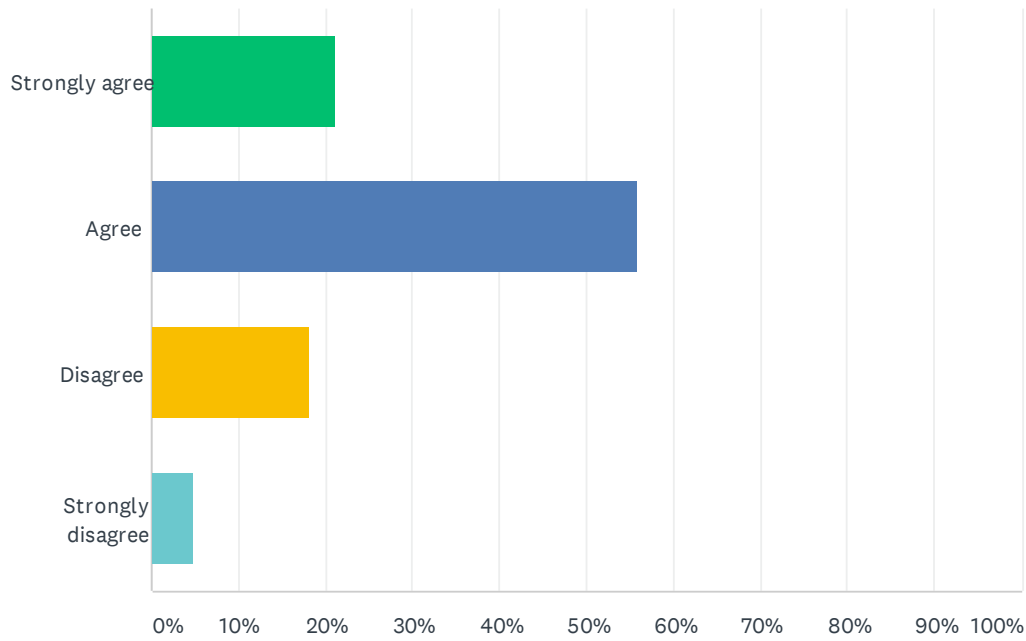

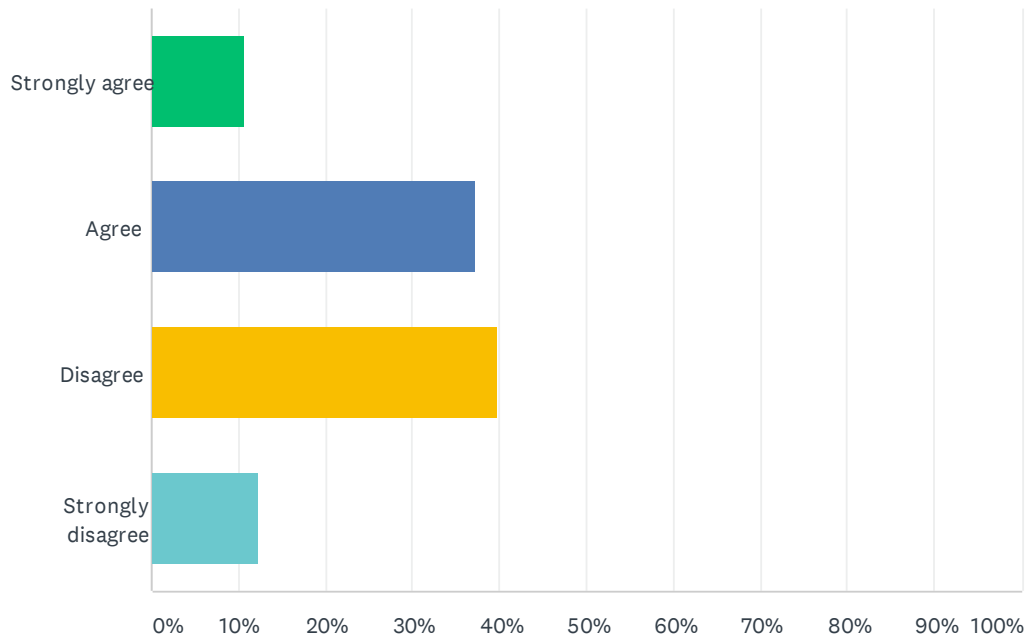

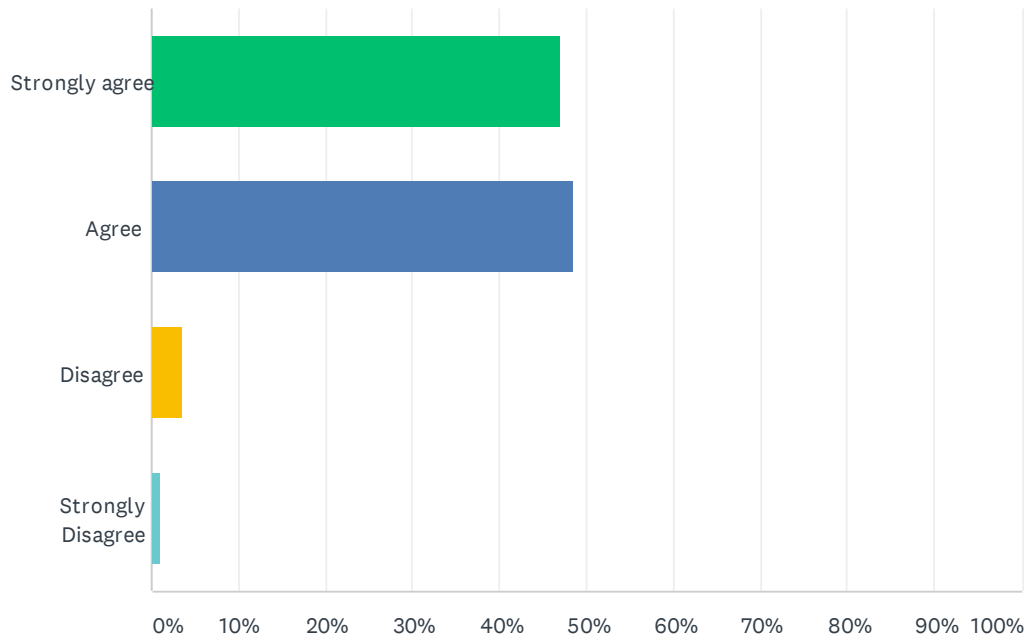

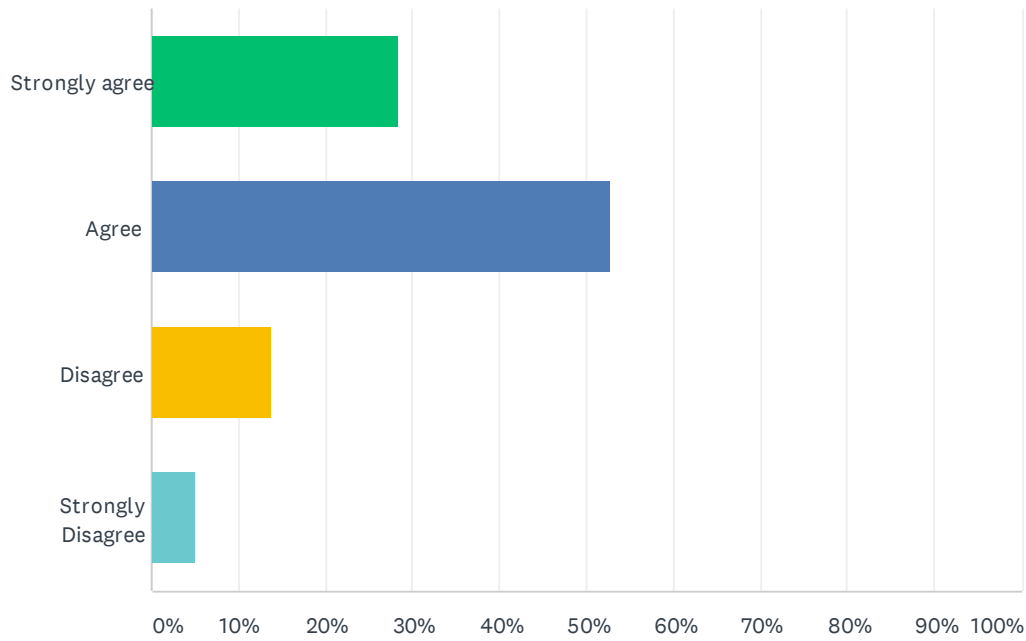

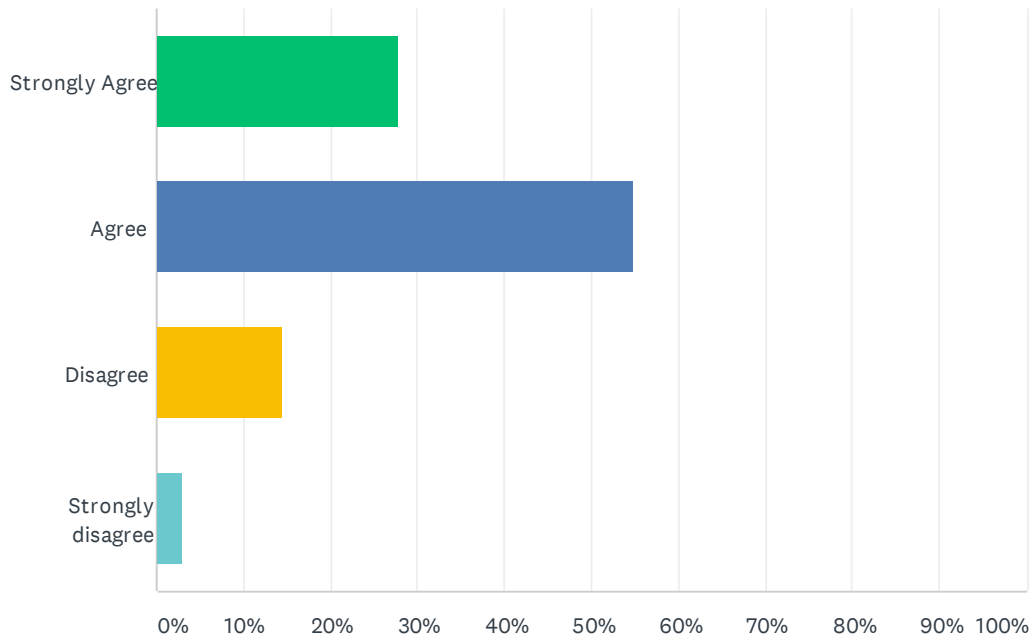

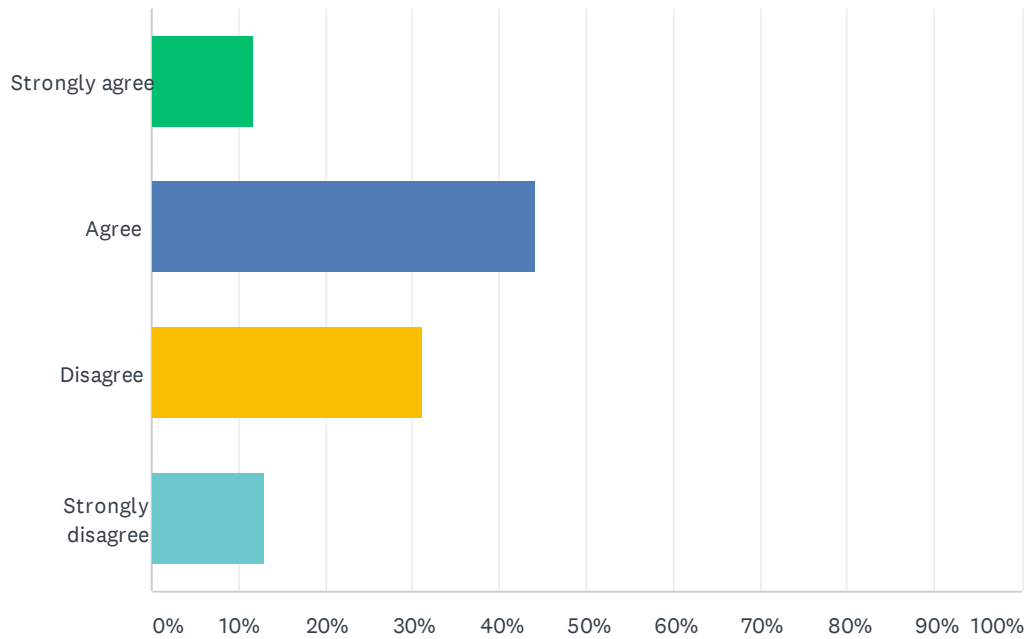

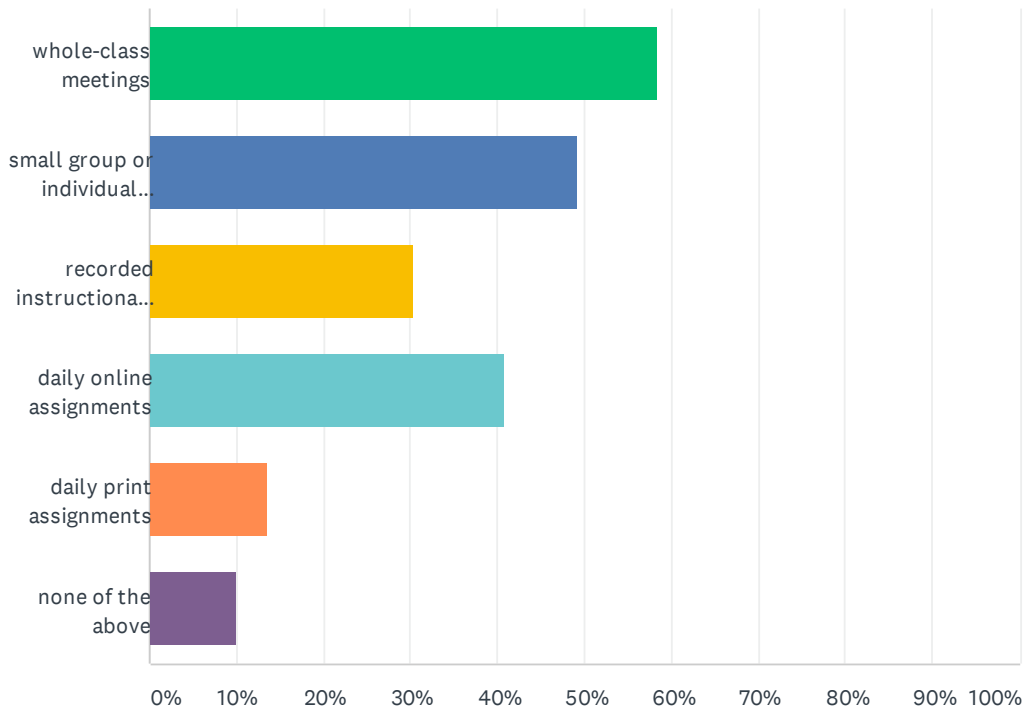

### Q14 What were the most engaging aspects of remote learning for your student?

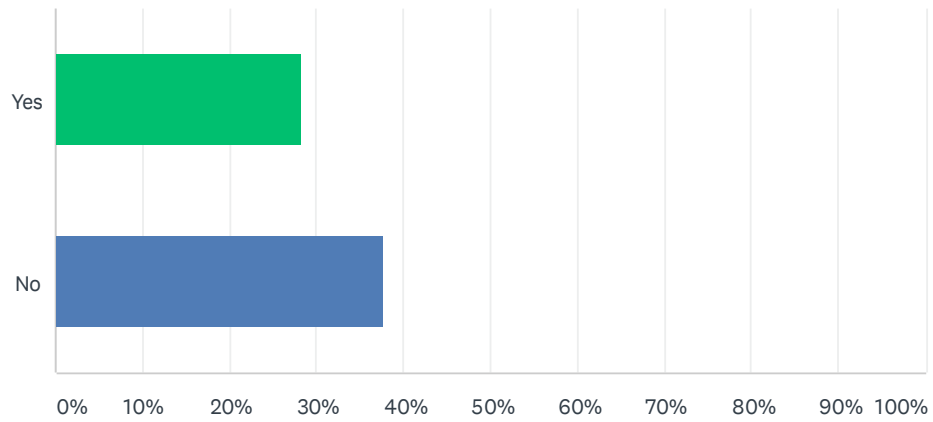

### Q15 If your student was in Grades K-2, did you and your student find the weekly grid boards manageable for remote learning?

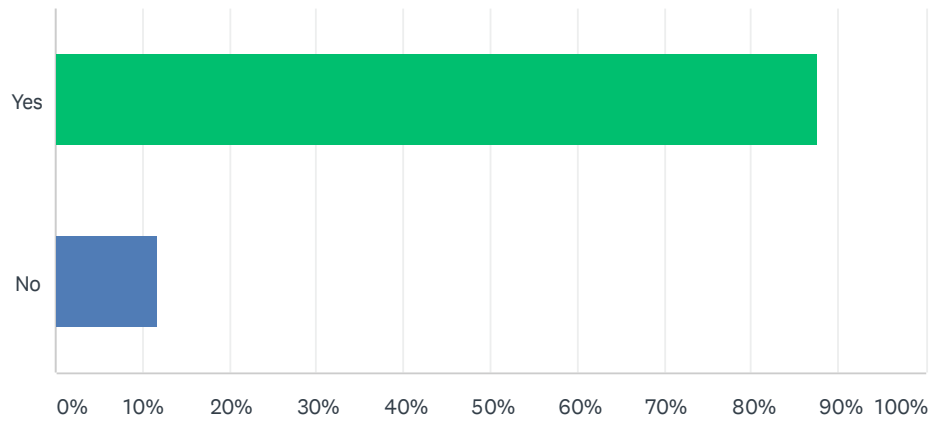

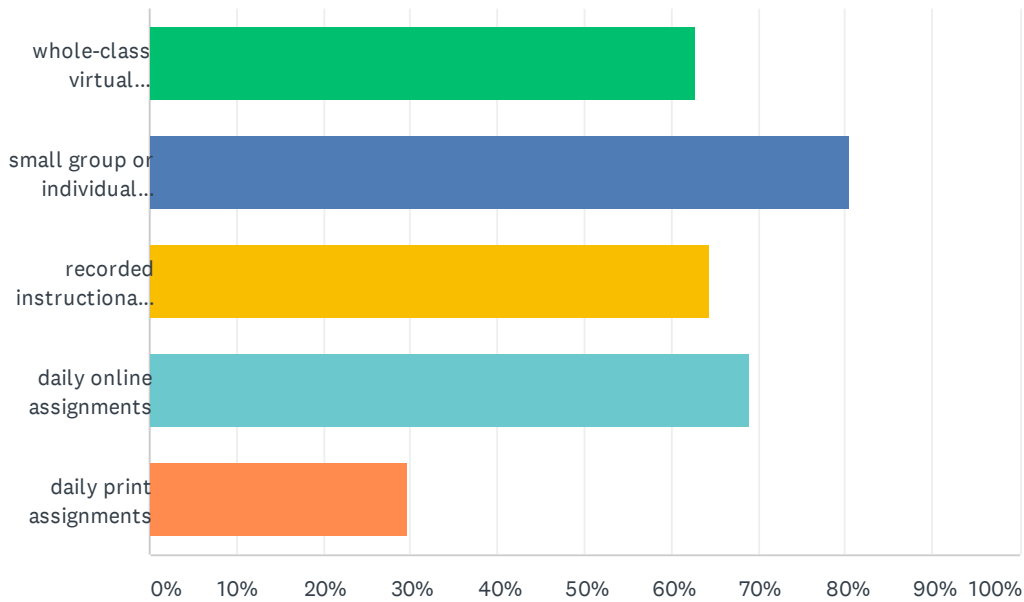

### Q17 What do you deem essential in a remote learning model? Check only those that you feel strongly about.

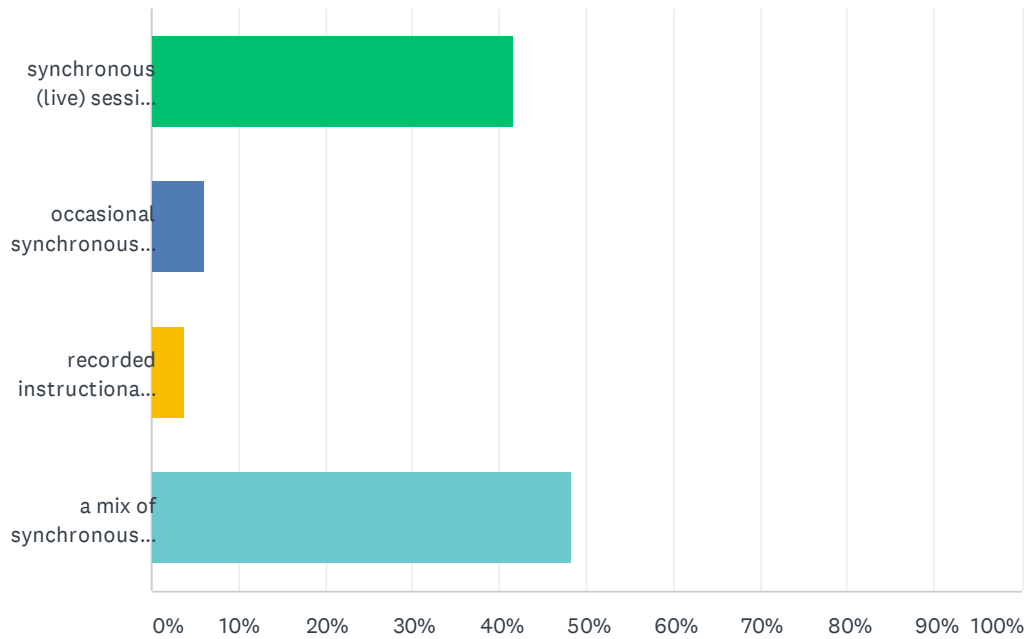

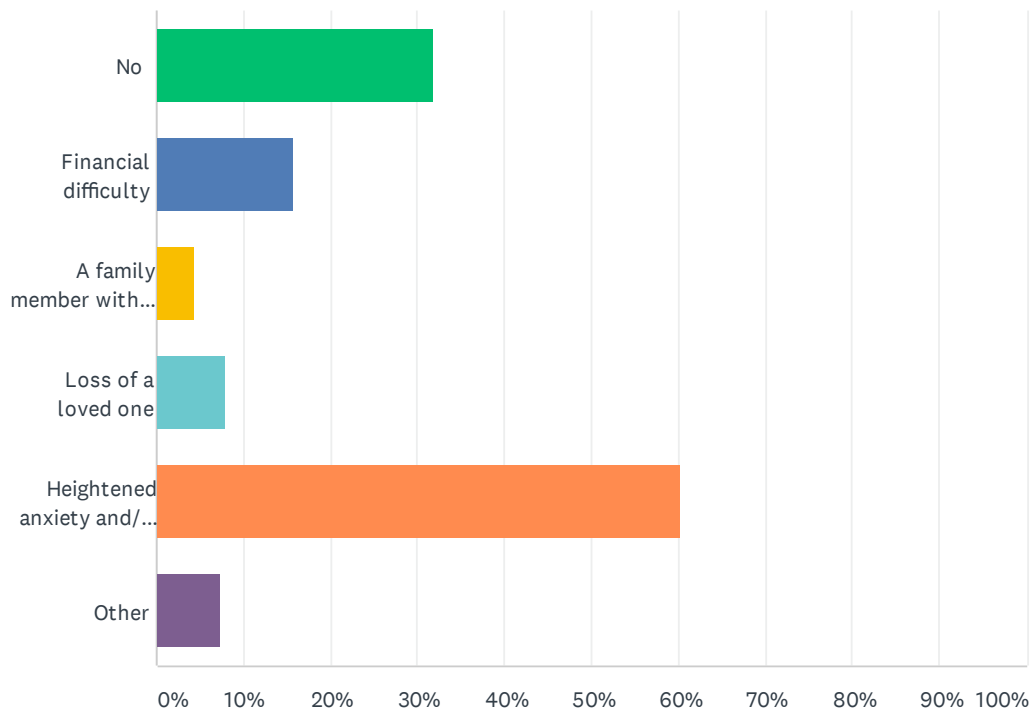

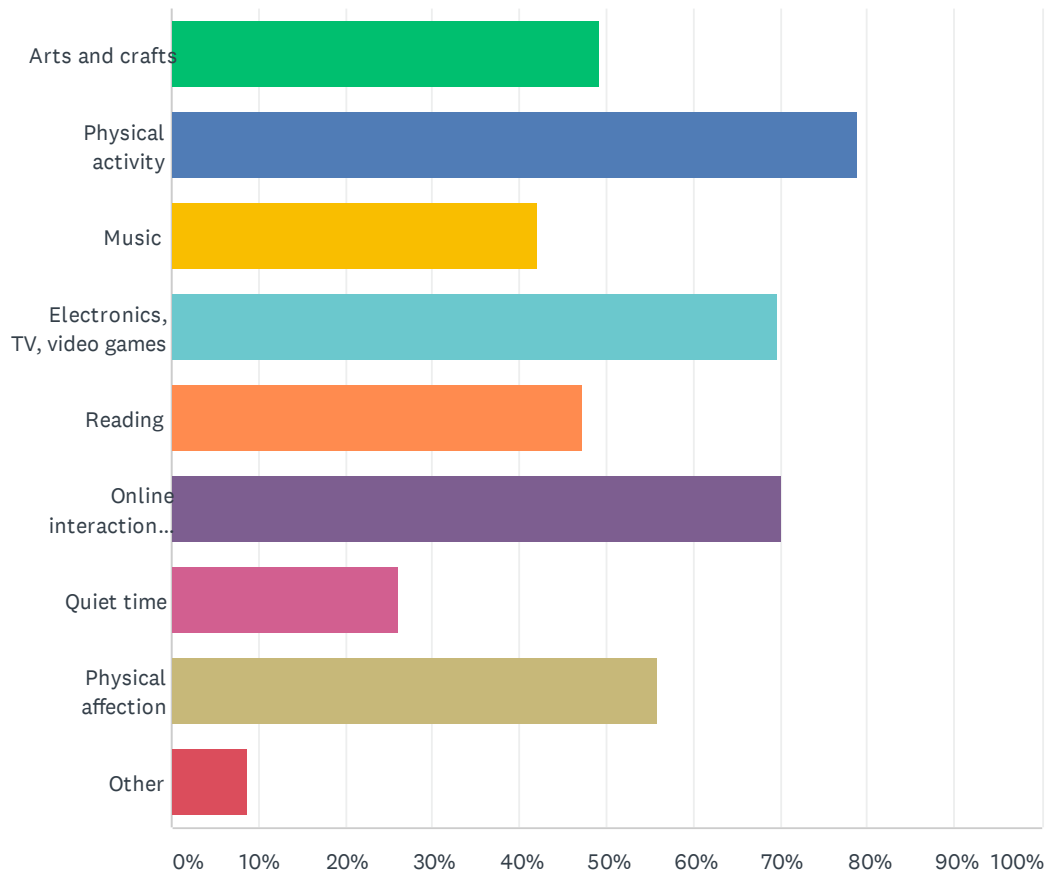

## Q21 What outlets/activities/strategies helped your student manage his/her emotions during the school closure? Check all that apply.

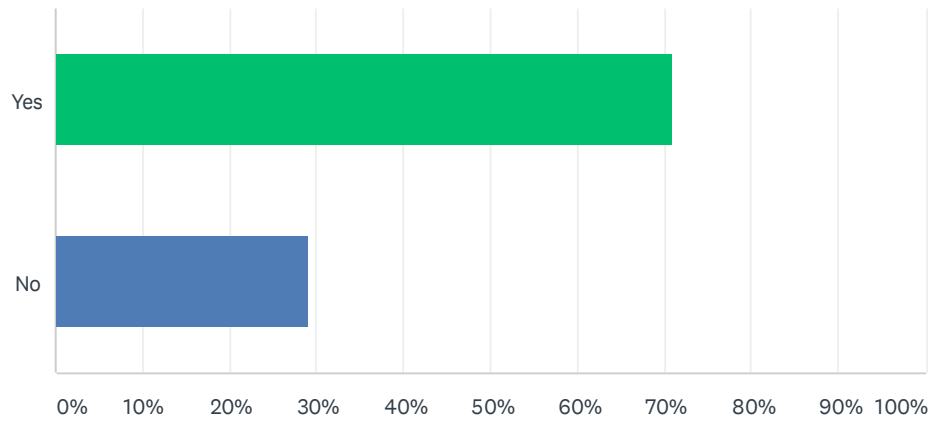

## Q22 Would you feel comfortable sending your student to school in the fall?

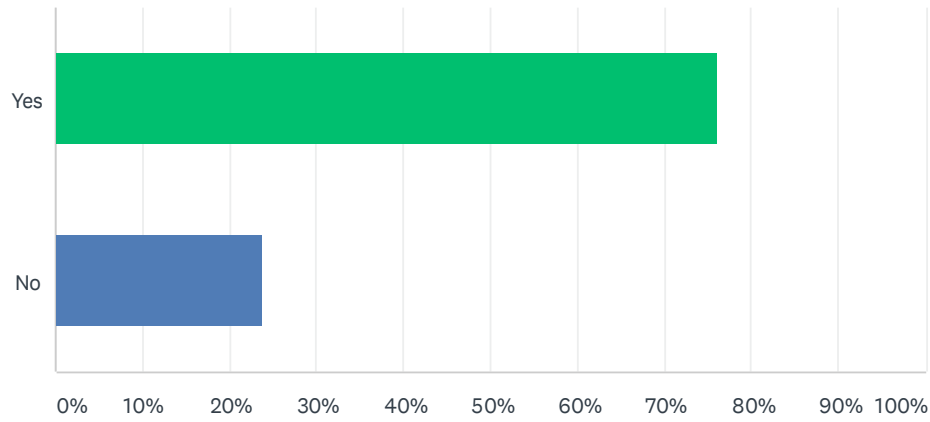

### Q23 Does your student feel comfortable returning to school in the fall?

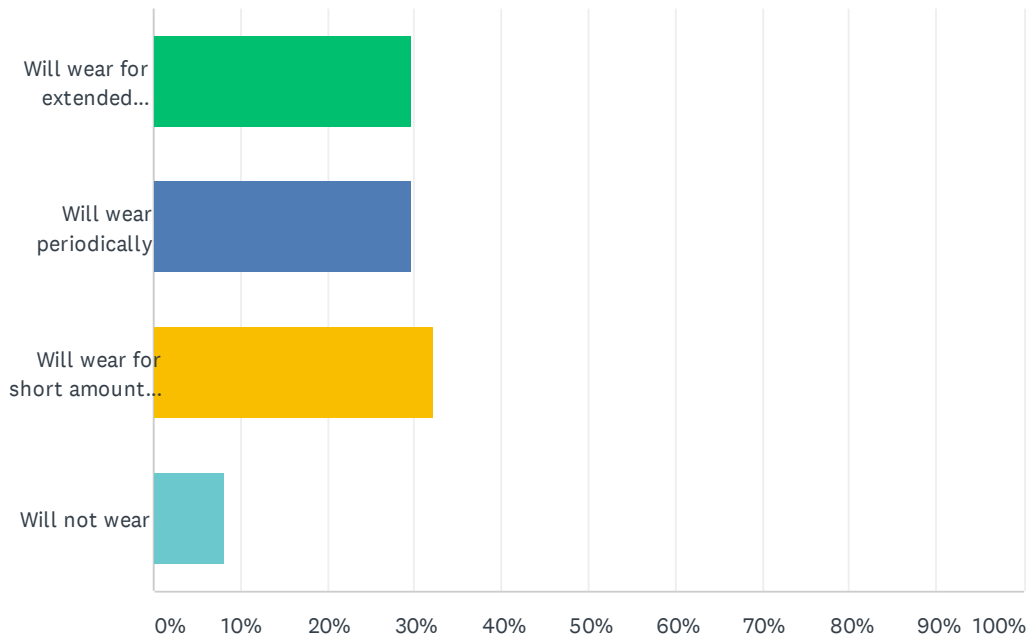

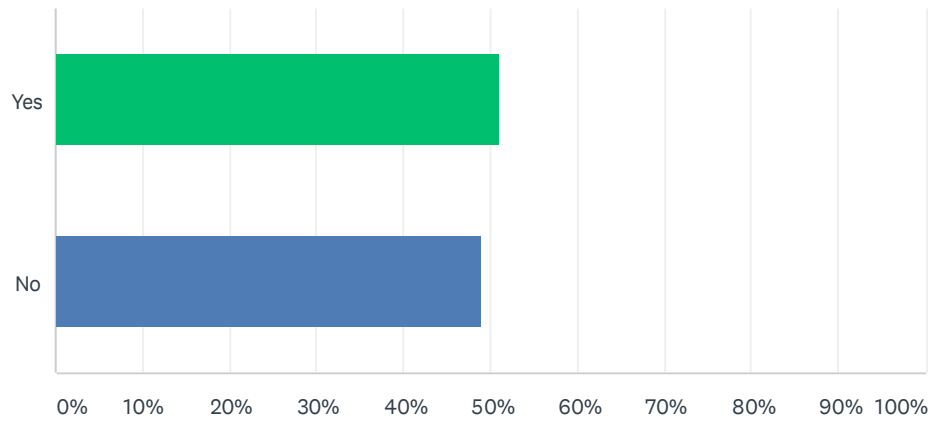

## Q25 When we return to school in the fall, would you prefer to provide your own transportation to school for your student?

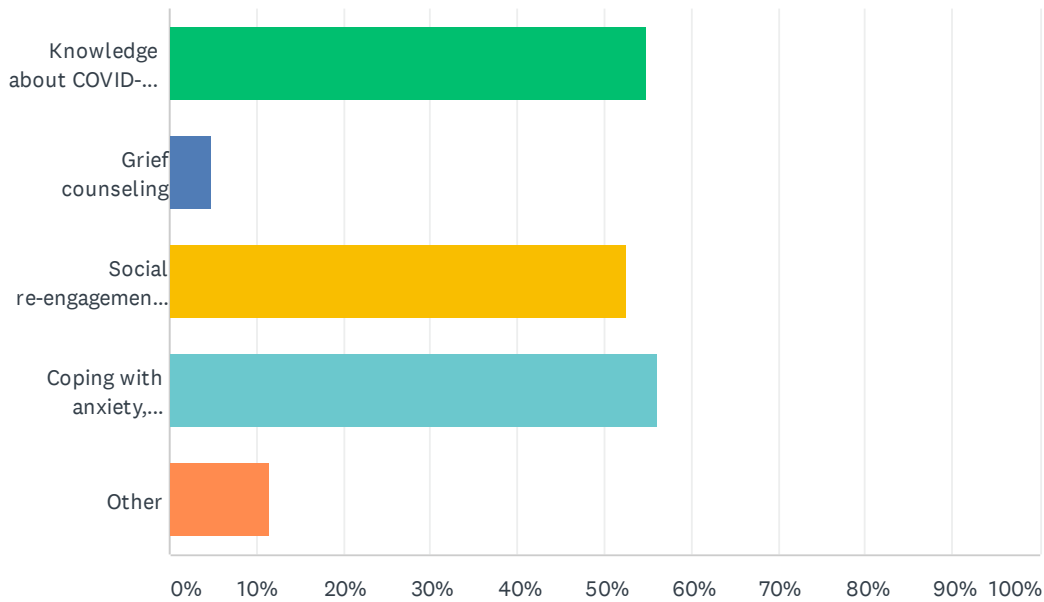
