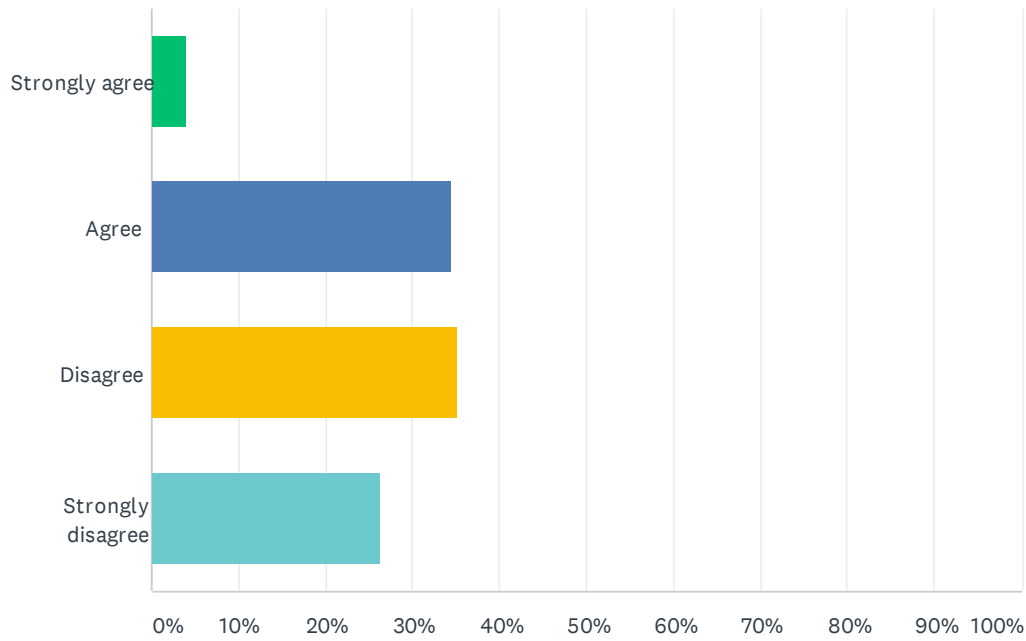

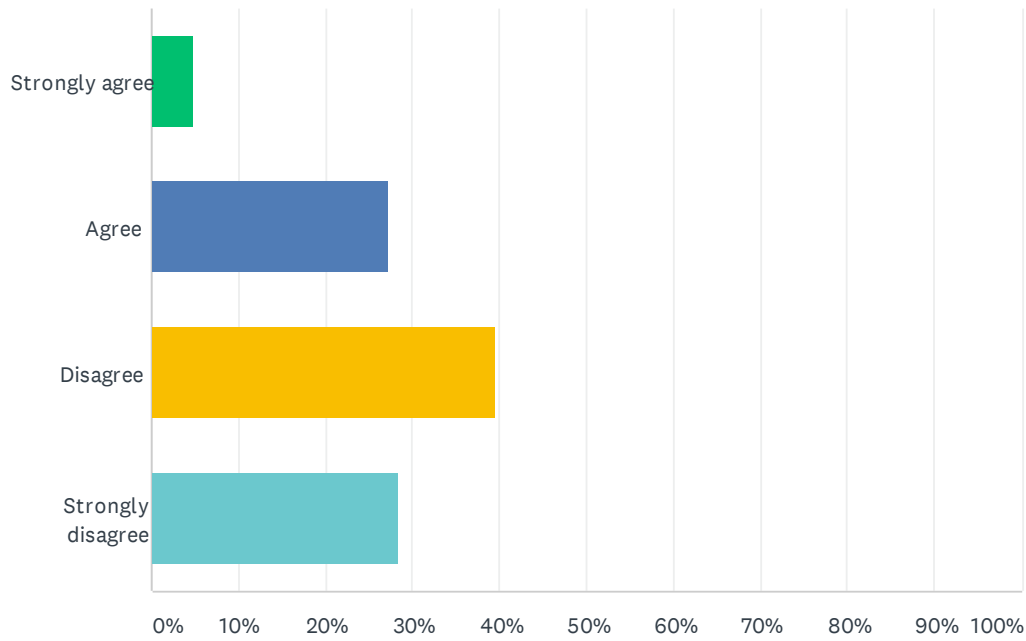

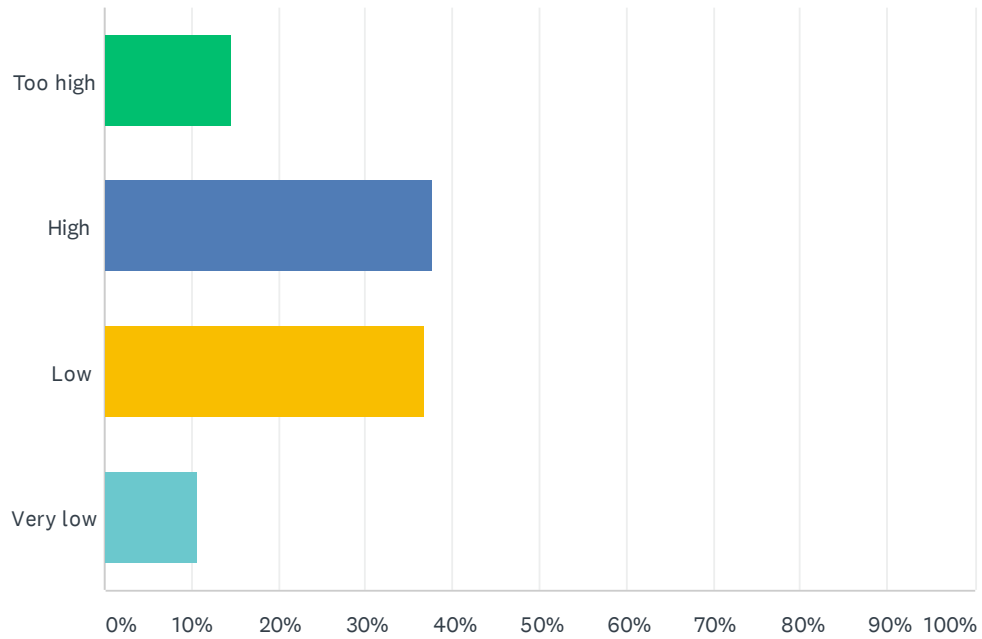

Q4 The stress level in your home related to remote learning was

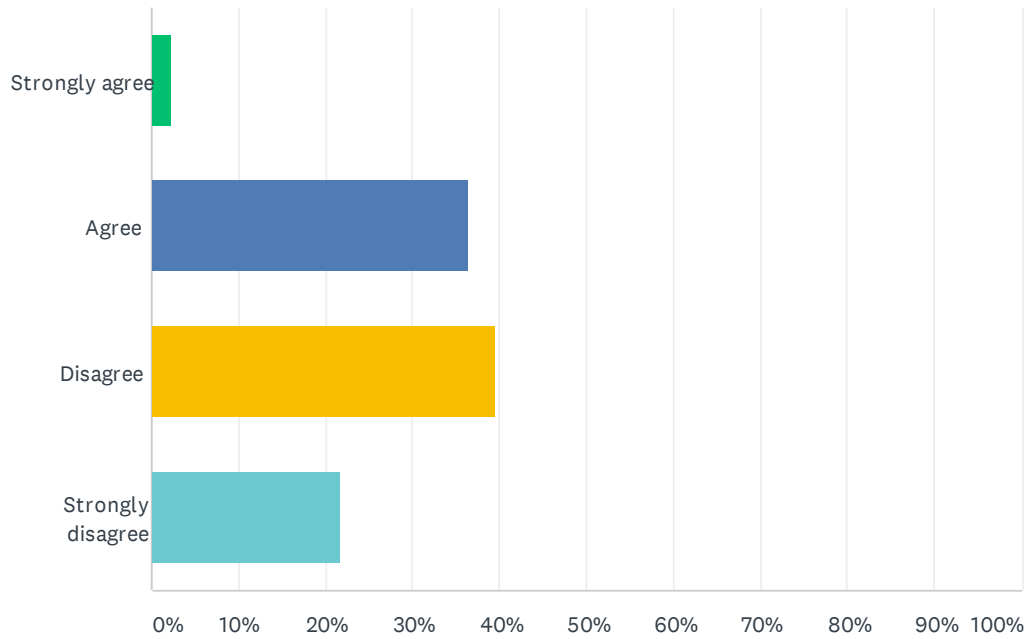

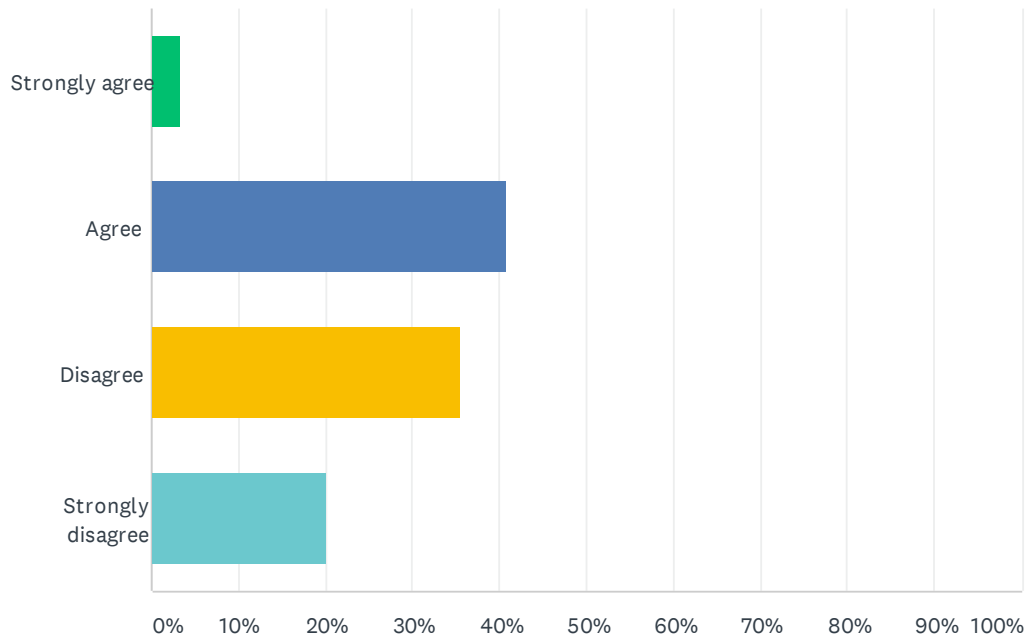

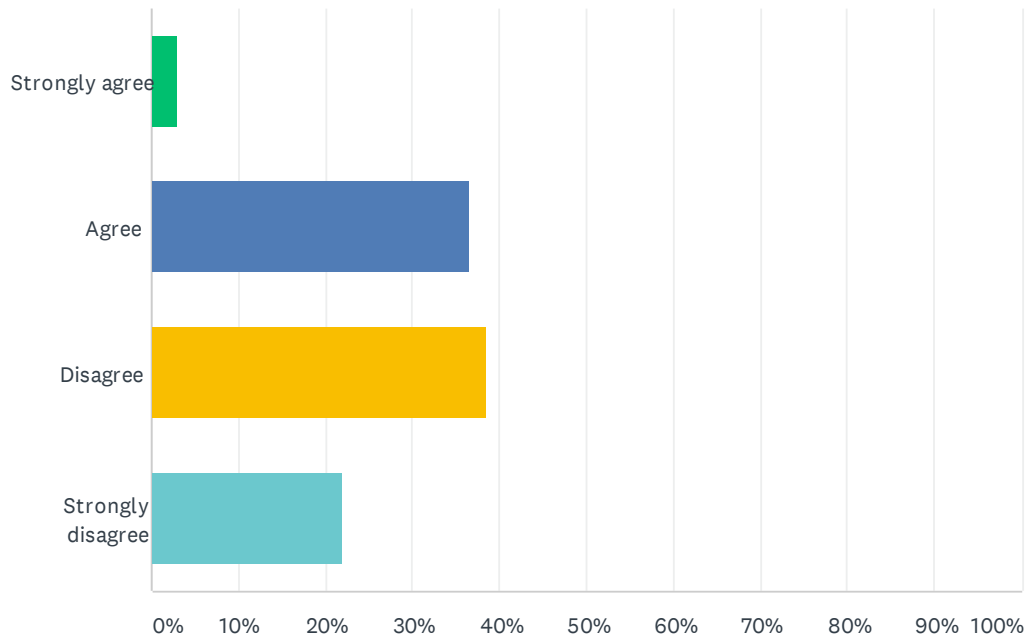

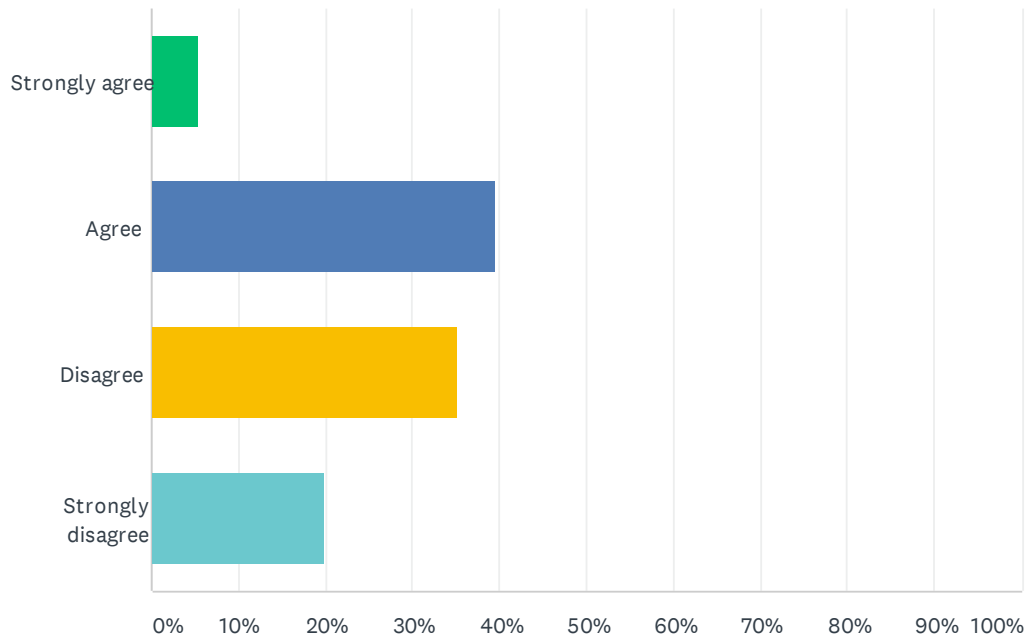

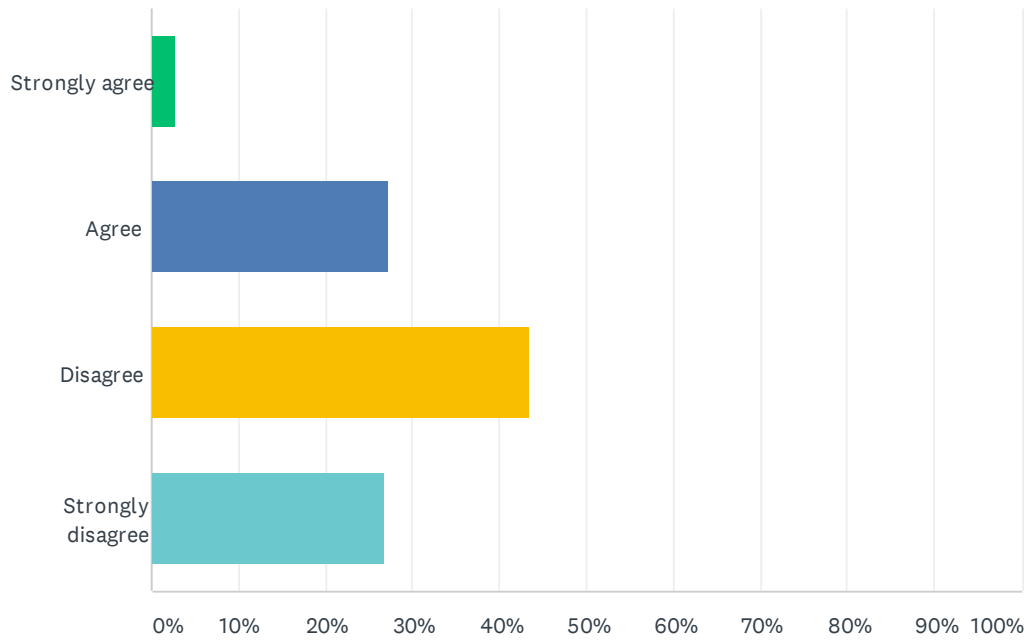

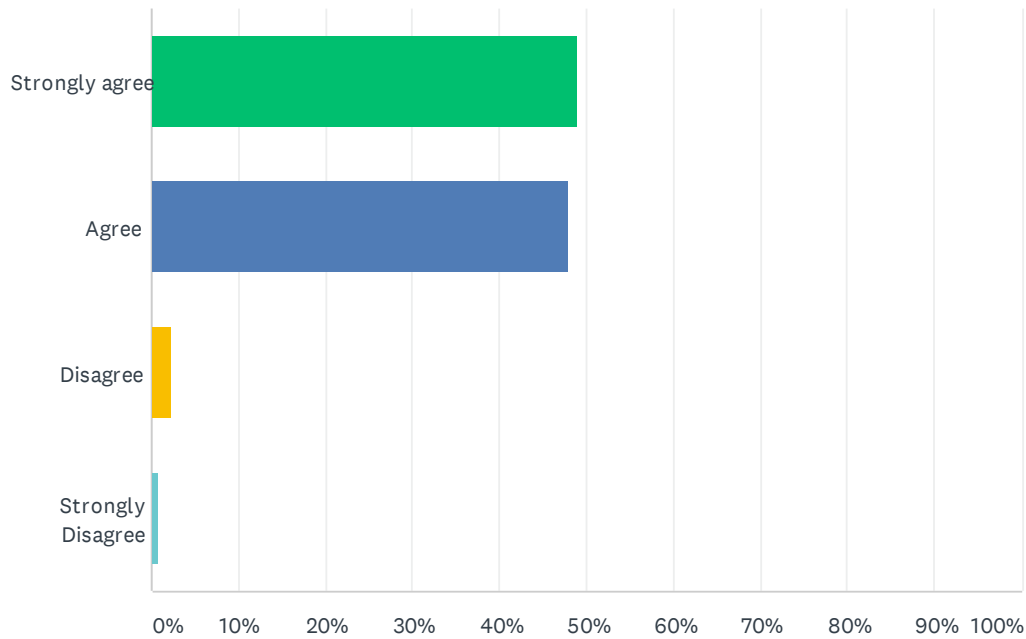

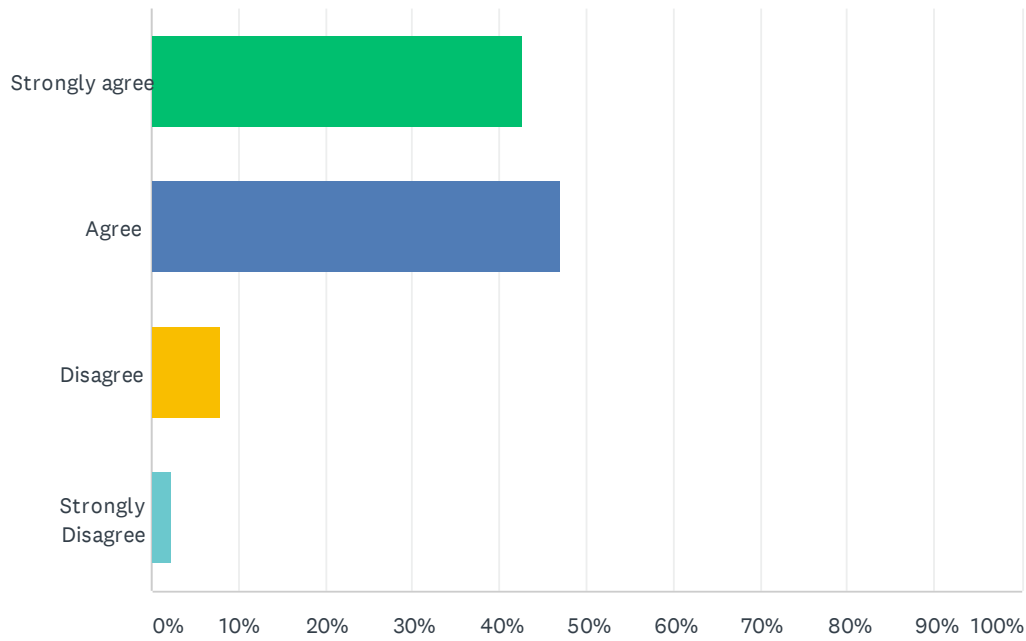

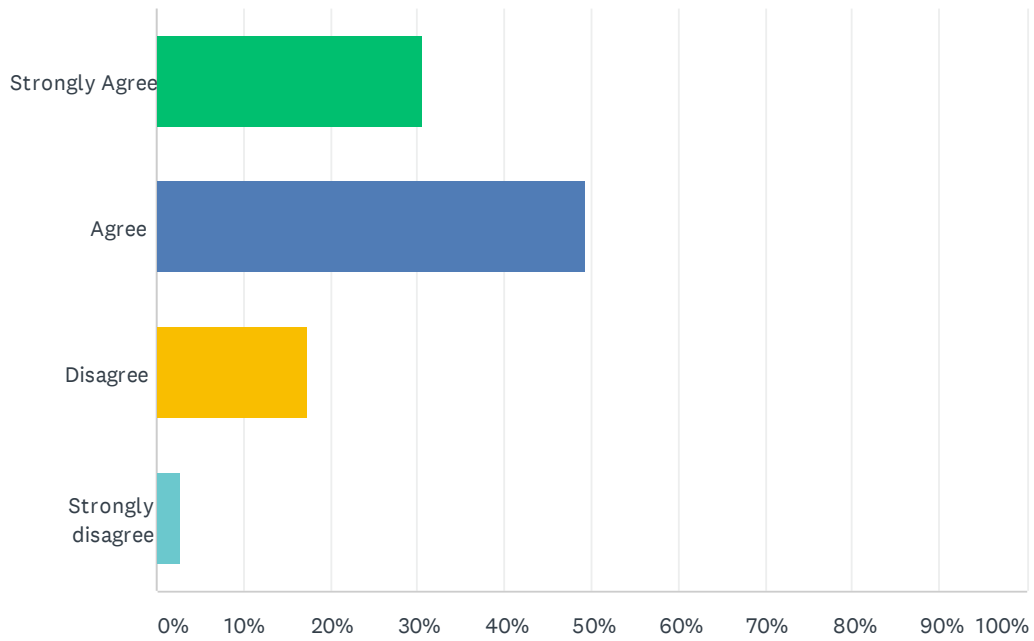

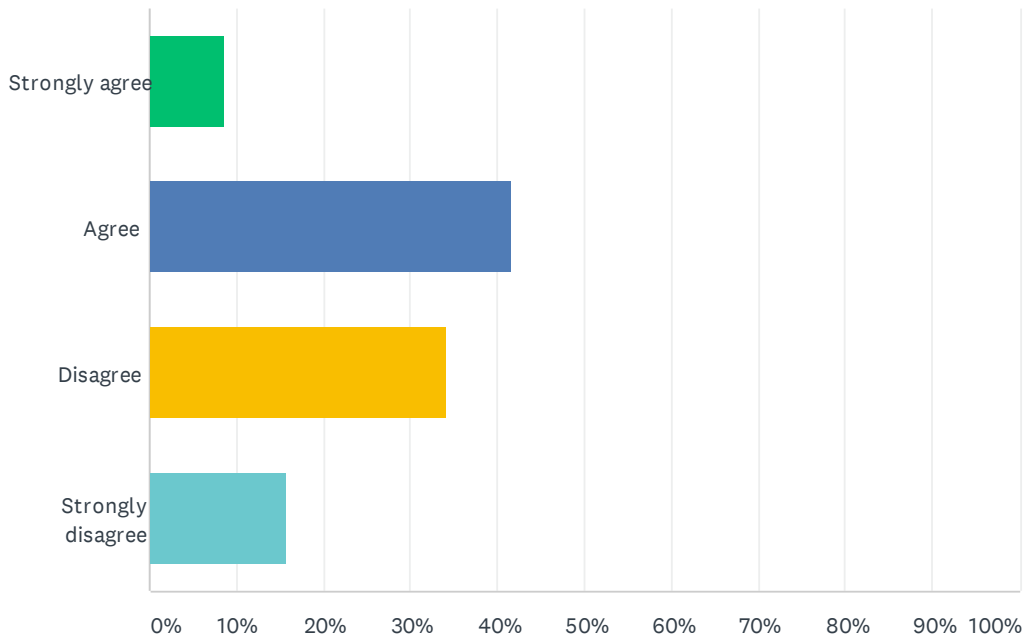

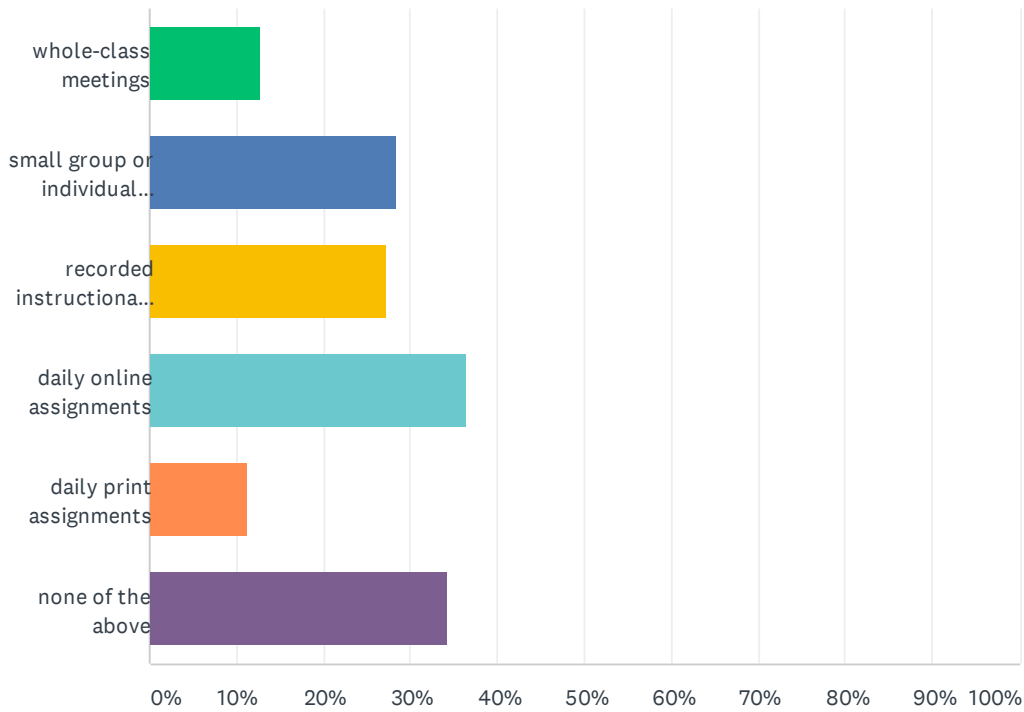

Q14 What were the most engaging aspects of remote learning for your student?

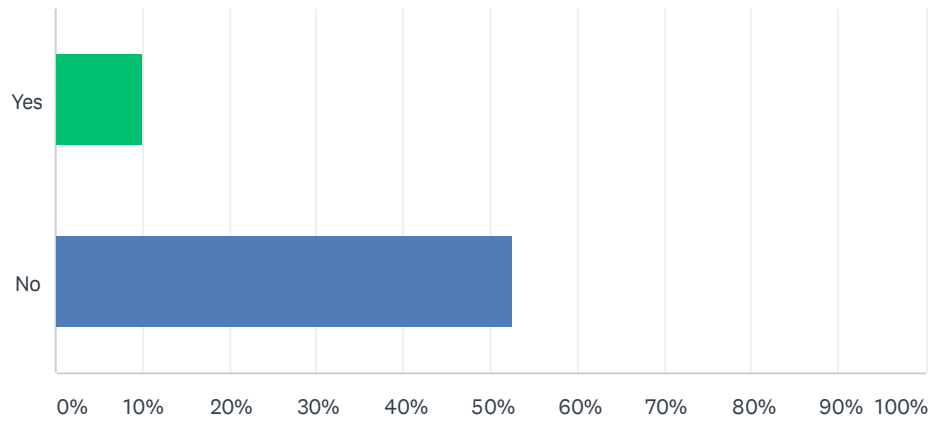

Q15 If your student was in Grades K-2, did you and your student find the weekly grid boards manageable for remote learning?

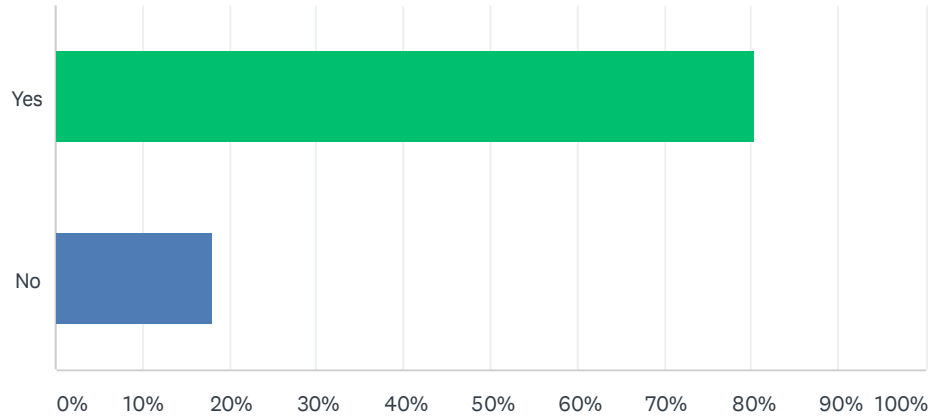

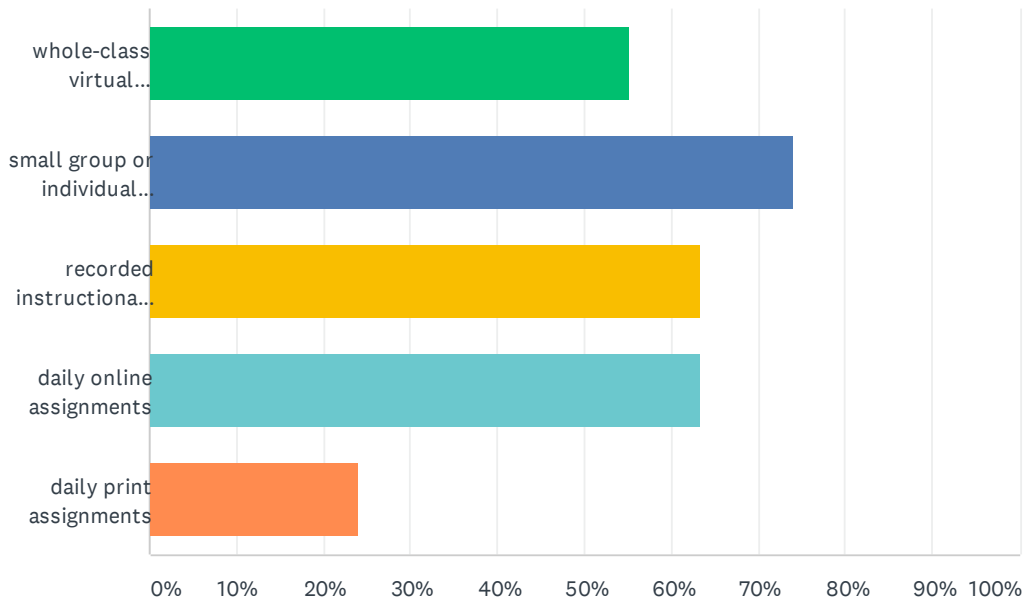

Q17 What do you deem essential in a remote learning model? Check only those that you feel strongly about.

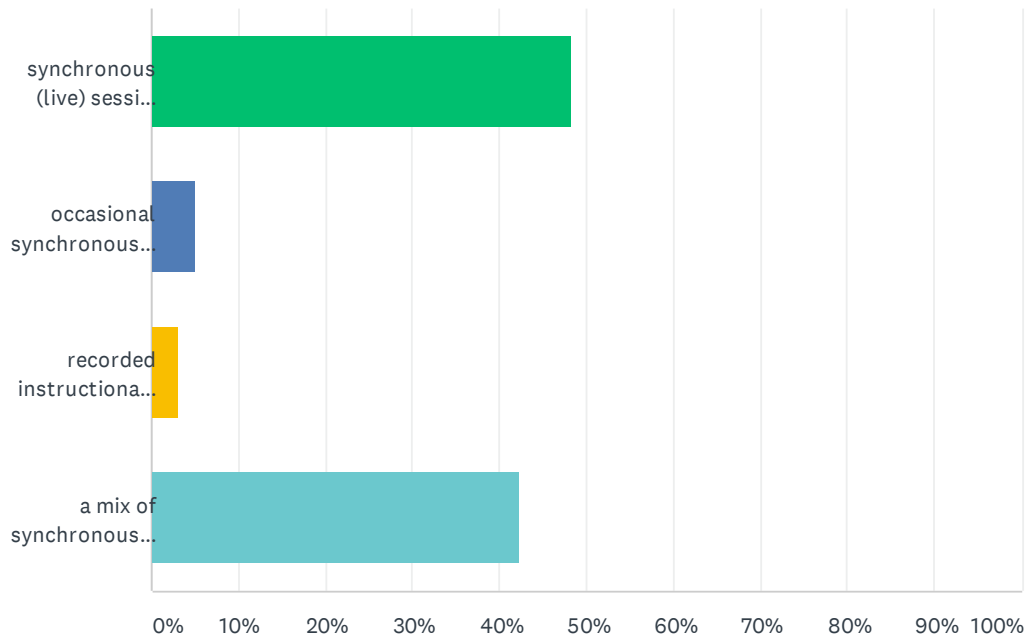

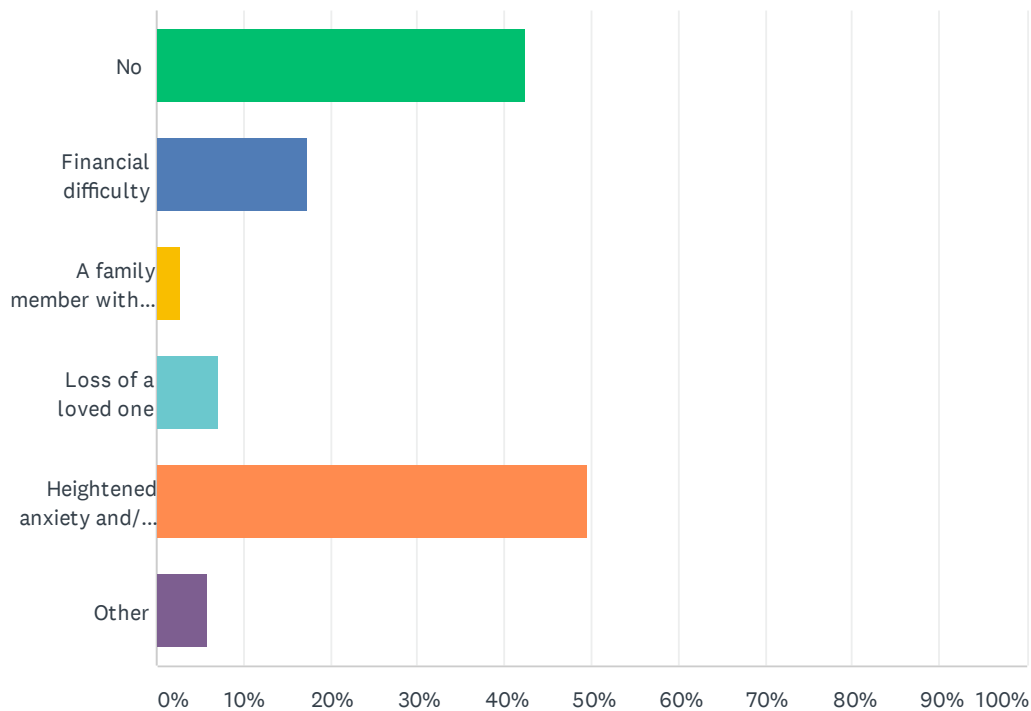

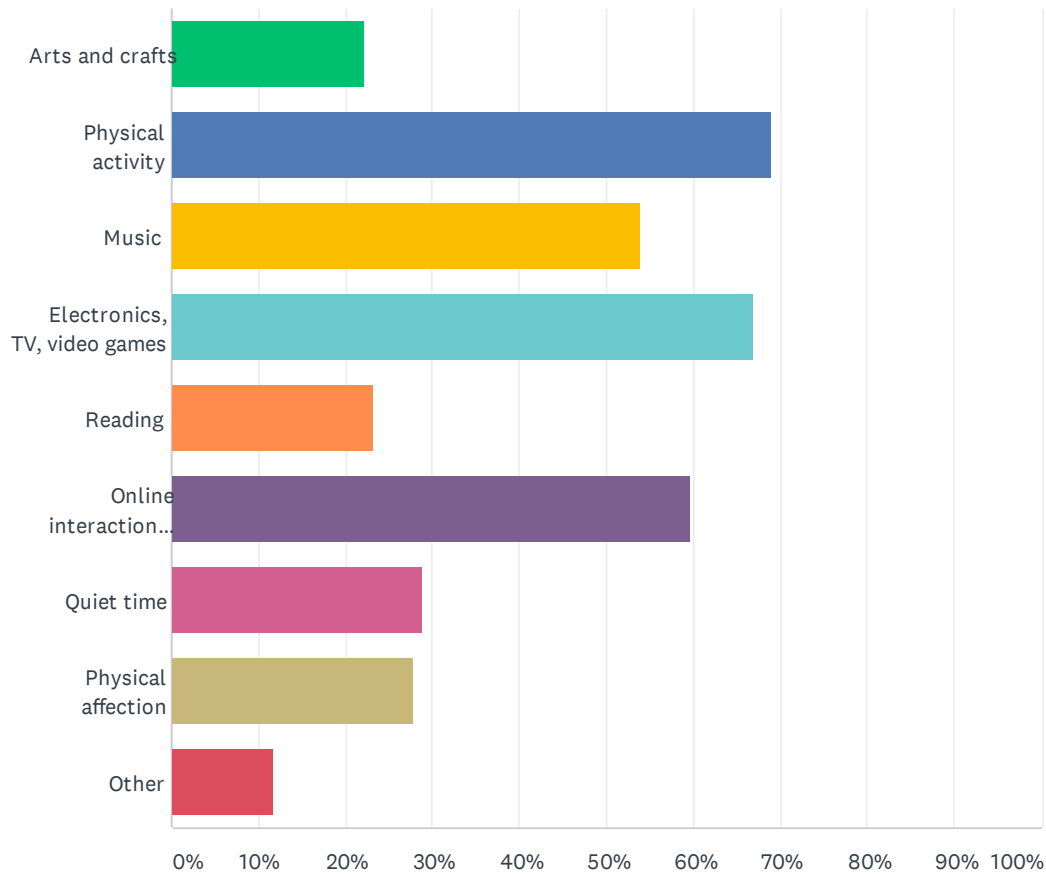

Q21 What outlets/activities/strategies helped your student manage his/her emotions during the school closure? Check all that apply.

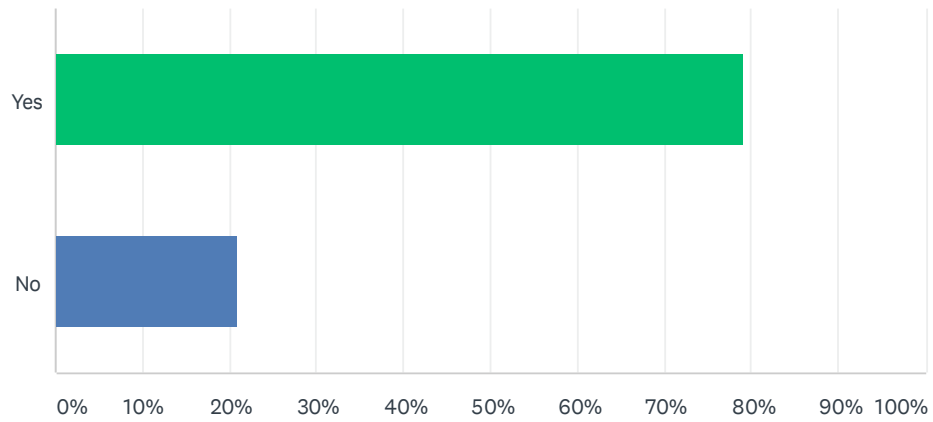

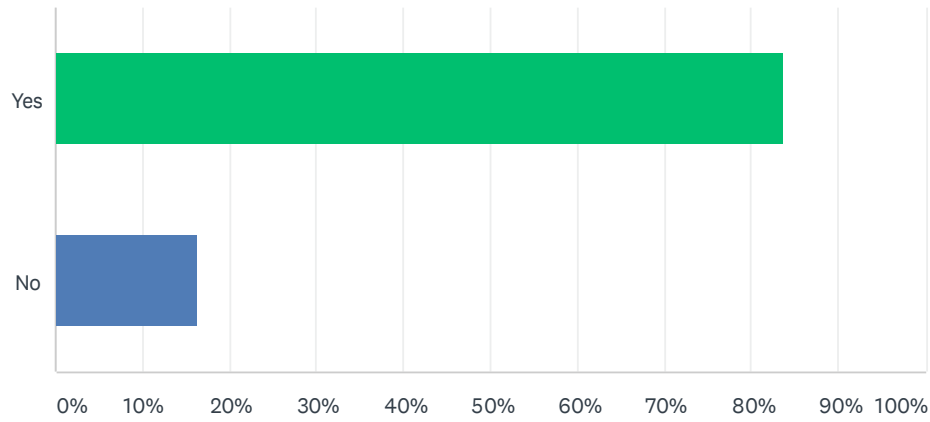

Q23 Does your student feel comfortable returning to school in the fall?

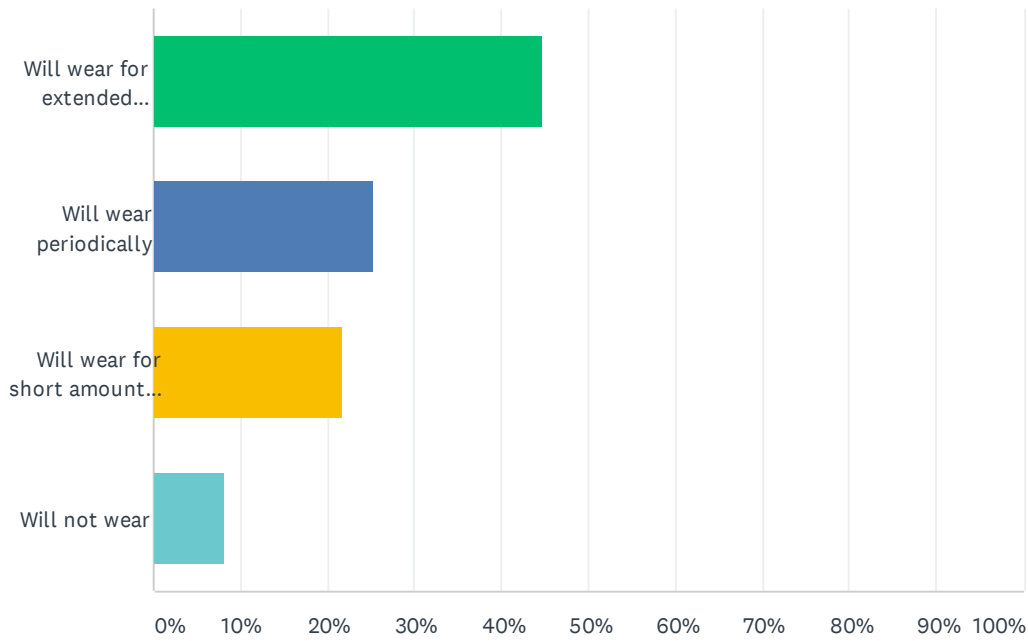

Q24 What is your student’s comfort level with wearing a face mask when returning to school in the fall?

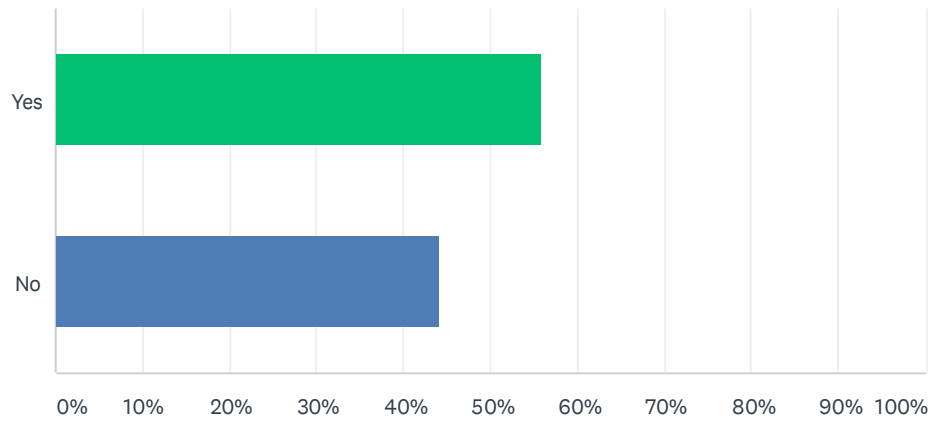

Q25 When we return to school in the fall, would you prefer to provide your own transportation to school for your student?

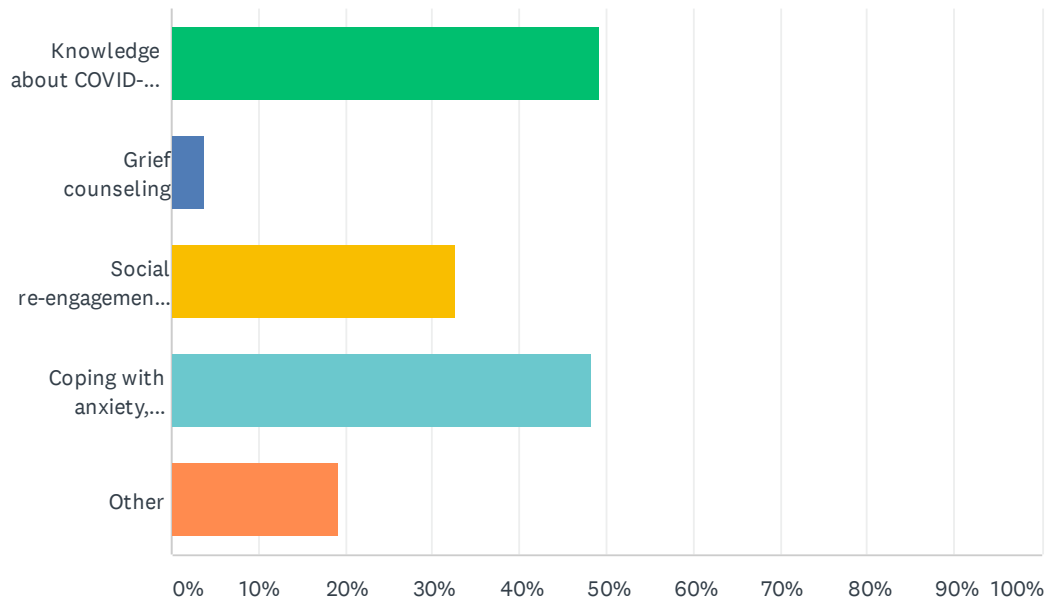
